


Transformation in business, education and entrepreneurship

HEI Transformation and Faculty Development

International Collaborations Build Entrepreneurial Ecosystems

We won seven British Council 'Creative Spark' contracts, partnering with Cass Business School, Essex Business School, London South Bank University and UWE Bristol. Working in Uzbekistan, Kyrgyzstan, Azerbaijan, Armenia, and Georgia, our 15 foreign HEI partnerships are the largest number for any British institution. The programme develops creative skills and entrepreneurial ecosystems.

- In the first year, across 5 projects in 4 countries, 2110 students and 96 staff underwent entrepreneurship training. In the previous year, there had been none.
- In June 2019 ChangeSchool teams were winners of 2 out of the 3 categories and won 4 prizes out of 9 overall in the National Pitching Competition in Armenia.
- In year 3, three projects from Tbilisi State University will be funded to start the commercialisation process in the World Bank Commercialisation and Technology Transfer programme in Georgia.
